We arrange the forms to be filled in, the co-ordination of all legal paperwork, and can advise on grants that may be available. As a matter of course we are kept up to date with any changes that may occur in Social Security regulations relating to Funeral grants and pay outs that may be applied for.

We are sympathetic towards different Ethnic and Religious groups, and as Funeral Directors we are aware of the special and personal needs involved in supporting those who have suffered a death whether expected or sudden.

Our Premises

We welcome you to Grady's on Hayling Island where we have run our Family business from since 1891, Incorporating today, our Arrangement Offices, Chapels of Rest, Cremated Remains Memorial Room, Mortuary, Garages for our Vehicle's and our own Garden Service Chapel.

Cost

When you arrange a Funeral with us, we shall advise you verbally of the **approximate** costing, followed by a written estimate detailing the cost of your requirements after final discussions with the Minister or Celebrant taking the service; Our written Estimate will provide payment details and terms of business given which we require to be adhered to.

Our Fees*

As your Funeral Director, we are here to advise you in making all those arrangements which meet personal needs and desires. We are here to help you in whatever way we can. Providing you with a personal 24 hour by phone, 365 days a year service, ensuring a continuance of care of your loved one into Grady's care.

Much of what we do is discreet, and it is not always apparent what duties are carried out, but cover our professional fees and overhead costs including:

- Provision of 24 hour a day personal call service and attendance and conveyance of the deceased to our Private Chapel of Rest on Hayling Island.
- Care of the deceased, dressing and preparation for viewing.
- Attendance for viewing and Chapel of Rest visit appointments.
- Professional advice and guidance in making Funeral arrangements, arranging documentation such as completion of necessary Cremation, ensuring all relevant paperwork is received by the relevant organisations in order for the Funeral to legally take place e.g. Crematorium, Church, or Natural Burial grounds.
- Appointing and liaising with Vicar, Minister or Celebrant.
- Ordering & arranging an organist, piper, choir, musician or recorded music to be played during the service.
- Arranging and ordering visual photographic tribute to be shown during the service if requested (only available at certain venues).
- Arrangement of Obituary notice in Newspapers If required.
- Administration and processing Donation payments.
- Arrangement of artwork and layout of Order of Service booklet If required.
- Provision of Funeral Director, Bearers and Drivers.
- Provision of Vehicles.

Disbursements

These are set fees that we have to pay in advance and are set by the relevant bodies carrying out services required.

Parochial Fee (For a Church Funeral).

Organist Fee, Piper, Choir or Musician - If required.

Grave Purchase or Re - open Fee - If required.

Minster or Celebrant Fee - If required.

Photographic Visual Fee - If required.

Webcast Fee - If required.

Printing of Order of Service - If required.

Newspaper Announcements - If required.

Floral Tributes - If required.

Coffin Charges - Dependant on choice.

Vehicle Hire Cost - Dependant on choice.

TYPE OF FUNERAL SERVICES

Choices of Funeral

There are various choices available to help you mark the end of a life, and help you achieve a meaningful and personal Funeral. Below is a brief outline of choices which we at Grady's can discuss in detail on a personal level during your arrangements with us as your Funeral Director. We can arrange Funeral Services for any culture and ethnicity as well as accommodate alternative forms of a farewell.

Religious Funeral

Can be conducted in a Church of your choice, followed by Burial or Cremation. This is led by a Minister of your choice. Services can also be held at a Crematorium, or at Grady's Garden Chapel, followed by Burial or Cremation, where we welcome Ministers of all denominations.

Civil Funeral or Humanist Funeral

Held in a Crematorium, Meeting Hall or Service Chapel at a Funeral Directors such as our Garden Chapel followed by the Cremation at a Crematorium or a Burial at a Churchyard, Cemetery or Green Burial Site.

A Civil Funeral is conducted by an Independent Funeral Celebrant, which may include music, reading, poetry and symbolic elements with no restrictions.

A Humanist Funeral contains no religious elements and is conducted by a trained Humanist Celebrant.

Direct Cremation

Non attended Cremation at a Crematorium without a service which is the most economic option.

Compliance, Regulations, Qualifications, Training and Expertise

Grady's Family Funeral Directors and employees are governed, trained, qualified and regulated in line with the The National Society of Allied & Independent Funeral Directors SAIF and the The National Association of Funeral Directors NAFD.

Documents

Once Documentation for the Funeral is completed by ourselves, we pass it onto the relevant Authorities with any other legal documents required.

All documentation and discussions about the Funeral will be retained for future reference by your family and ourselves. All information is kept in absolute confidence in accordance with GDPR guidelines.


HOW TO REGISTER

The Registrar will ask for the following information about the Deceased:

- Date and place of death and usual address.
- Full name and surname (and maiden name if the Deceased was a women who had married).
 - Date and place of birth.
- Occupation (and the name and occupation of her husband if the Deceased was a married woman or widow).
 - Whether he or she was receiving a pension/ allowance from public funds.
 - If the Deceased was married, the date of birth of the surviving widow(er).
- The Deceased's Medical Card, Birth Certificate, Marriage Certificate if available should be taken to the Registrar.

You will be given by the Registrar:

- 1. Certificate, green in colour, to give to Funeral Director to allow Burial or Cremation to take place.
 - 2. Certificate to cancel Deceased's state pension, if applicable.
 - 3. Death Certificates must be purchased at time of need. Registrar will advise as to how many copies you will require.

Pre Paid Funerals

A funeral plan is an easy way to arrange the funeral you want in advance. A plan allows you to specify your wishes and pay for the funeral director's services included in your plan. As customers often tell us, that can bring peace of mind to you and your family. A plan from Golden Charter also includes an allowance towards third party costs. These are essential, non-funeral director services such as the cremation or burial fees, plus the minister or officiant's fee to perform the service.

At Grady's, we work in partnership with Golden Charter to provide you with a simple way to plan ahead. As one of the UK's largest funeral plan providers, Golden Charter has helped over 900,000 people to plan ahead, so we're completely confident in offering their plans to you.

Everyone has different needs when it comes to funeral planning, so we make sure the plans we offer are as flexible as possible. When you get in touch, we'll be happy to discuss your funeral requirements and tailor a plan to suit you. Rest assured a plan from Golden Charter is available to all UK residents regardless of age or state of health.

A plan to suit your needs

As an independently owned funeral director, we'll take the time to understand your wishes and tailor a plan to suit you. We can discuss these at our premises or in your home, at a time that is convenient for you. If you'd prefer to discuss this over the phone or via email, we can assist with this too. You can tell us about any preferences you have in mind — the type of funeral you would like to have, hymns, music or any other personal touches — and we'll make sure your plan takes these into account.

What's included in a pre-paid funeral plan?

Our funeral director's services will be covered in your funeral plan, which means our fees will be fixed at today's prices and protected against rising costs. These services typically include:

- Professional services and making arrangements for the funeral
- Transportation of the deceased from the place of death to our premises, chapel of rest or other suitable location
- · Care of the deceased and preparations for family viewing if requested
- Advice on the certification and registration of death and related documentation
- Provision of funeral vehicles
- · Advice on bereavement counselling
- Coffin or casket requested

Although a pre-paid funeral plan can cover all of the services above, there are some additional third party costs to consider. These are the costs for essential, non-funeral director services required to carry out a cremation or burial which need to be paid at the time of the funeral. These costs are outside our control. Depending on the plan type chosen, a Golden Charter funeral plan can include a contribution towards some third party costs.

There will only be more to pay at the time of the funeral if the third party costs exceed the allowance when you buy your plan, or if the costs increase by more than the growth of your plan. However, even if prices rise in the future, you'll have the reassurance of knowing there'll be nothing more to pay for our funeral director's services included in the plan once your plan is fully paid for — guaranteed.

The retail price of your funeral plan is representative of the equivalent cost of a funeral today plus an arrangement fee of £325 which is retained by Golden Charter to help cover the costs of setting up your plan.

Your payments are held within the Golden Charter Trust. With almost £1.2 billion under management, the Trust is operated by a Board of Trustees, completely independent of Golden Charter. Their role is to hold your payments and ensure that the funeral director services in your plan can be paid for at the time they are required – however far into the future that may be. FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

In our opinion these is no such thing as a normal Funeral. Each and every Funeral is individual to the family concerned. It is up to the family to pay their last respects and say their farewell in the manner that is most suitable for them. The following information is there to help answer questions that we are most often asked about the Funeral and Service associated with it: -

Q: HOW MANY PEOPLE CAN BE SEATED IN THE LIMOUSINE?

A: In the lead limousine there is room for six people. (Restrictions may apply).

Q: HOW DO WE KNOW WHATTO DO ATTHE FUNERAL?

A: On the day of the Funeral, the Funeral Director is there to help and guide you, your family and friends. If you are unsure of anything please ask the Funeral Director.

Q: CANTHE FAMILY CARRYTHE COFFIN?

A: Yes, although we would ask that you contact us as soon as possible to ensure that it is safe to do so.

Q: CAN WE VISIT THE DECEASED AND PAY OUR LAST RESPECTS?

A: Yes, our Funeral Home is open and available to you anytime. If you wish to visit our private chapel, please ring and inform us when you would like to come and we will be pleased to arrange for a member of staff to meet you. (Out of office hours will include a charge Or Costs could be incurred if the Funeral Date Exceeds 20 days after the arrangements are made. £10.00.)

Q: NOTICE FOR THE NEWSPAPER?

A: If you require either a Death Notice or Acknowledgment in a local or national newspaper, please let us know either in person or by E-mail.

Q: IS EACH CREMATION CARRIED OUT INDIVIDUALLY?

A: Yes, the identity of the coffin name plate is checked by the Cremation attendant before it is placed in the Cremation Chamber. This only holds one coffin or casket at a time and again there are rules that must be abided by.

): CAN WE HAVETHE DECEASED BROUGHT HOME?

A: Yes, we can bring the deceased home, either on the evening before the service, or on the morning of the service, so the Deceased can leave from home.

Q: CAN WE CHOOSE WHAT MUSIC IS PLAYED AT THE CREMATORIUM?

A: Yes, if you have a special request or would like a particular piece of music playing either as you walk into or out of the Crematorium Chapel, please let the Funeral Director know as soon as possible. Please note that only original recordings are allowed because of copyright laws.

Q: CAN WE REQUEST DONATIONS TO CHARITY?

A: Yes, if donations to charity are requested in lieu of flowers, we will setup a MuchLoved online page where we donations are forwarded instantly to the charity of your choice.

Q: ARETHE HANDLES ON THE COFFIN REMOVED BEFORE THE CREMATION TAKES PLACE?

A: No, there are strict laws regarding Cremation. Once at the Crematorum nothing may be removed from the coffin before Cremation without the permission of the Home Office.

Q: DOES THE COFFIN MOVE AFTER THE FUNERAL SERVICE AT THE CREMATORIUM?

A: No, After the service has ended, the coffin does not move until all relatives and friends have left the Crematorium Chapel. At some Crematoria there are curtains that close at the head of the coffin, but this is only done at the request of the relatives.

Q: WHAT ABOUT CATERING AFTER THE FUNERAL?

A: If you require catering after the Funeral you can make your own arrangements, contact us to make a booking at a hotel or restaurant or visit our website to where wake venues can be viewed.

Q: HOW SOON AFTER A BURIAL CAN I PUT A HEADSTONE ON THE GRAVE?

A: If the grave is 'earth' rather than 'bricked' then the grave will take 12 months or more before the ground is firm enough to place the weight of a headstone. If the grave is 'bricked' inside, then it does not take as long.

Q: WHAT CAN I DO WITH THE CREMATED REMAINS?

- 1. You can place them in the Garden of Remembrance.
- 2. You may wish to purchase a grave just for the purpose of interring the Cremated Remains. This allows you to have a headstone and have other members of the family buried there, in the future.
- 3. You may keep them at home in a special urn or memorial.
- 4. You may scatter them in a special place.
- 5. The remains may be buried in an existing family grave.

 If you would like to discuss any of the above alternatives, please contact us and we will be pleased to help you.
- 6. Placed in Grady's Memorial Room with personal plaque.

Q: HOW WILL I KNOW WHO ATTENDED THE FUNERAL?

A: A list of mourners who attended the Funeral can be made, and written in a memorial book (if required). Cards can be filled out if service held at a Church or at Grady's Garden Chapel.

O: DO I GETTHE CREMATED REMAINS BACKTHAT BELONGTO ME?

A: Yes, once the Cremation has taken place, the Cremated Remains are left to cool before placed in an urn. This urn is clearly identified as to whose remains they are.

Q: WHERE IS MY LOVED ONE TAKEN AFTER YOU COLLECT THEM?

A: Once we bring your loved one into our care, they remain with us here on Hayling Island in our Chapel of Rest, unless the coroner is involved. We ensure they are settled with us as soon as possible, allowing you to arrange a private visit if you wish.

Q: HOW SOON CAN A FUNERAL TAKE PLACE AFTER A PASSING?

A: Typically, a funeral service can be arranged within 2-3 weeks after a loved one's passing, depending on your preferences and any religious or cultural practices. If the coroner is involved, however, there may be delays to allow for necessary procedures. We will keep you informed throughout the process and work to schedule the service as soon as possible.

CHECKLIST

Would you like family and friends to attend the burial or cremation? What type of service would feel most fitting—perhaps an intimate gathering, a traditional ceremony, or a celebration of life?

3) MUSIC CHOICES

Are there particular songs or musical pieces that hold significance and would bring comfort to family and friends during the service?

4) VISUAL LIFETRIBUTES

Would you like a visual tribute shown during the service, such as photos or videos set to music, at a crematorium or chapel?

5) COFFIN, CLOTHING, AND SERVICE LOCATION

Do you have preferences for the coffin style, clothing, or the service location itself?

6) FLORAL CHOICES

Is there a preference for specific flowers, or a request for simplicity in floral arrangements?

7) VEHICLE CHOICES

What type of vehicle would you or your loved one prefer for the final journey—hearse, horse-drawn carriage, motorcycle, or limousine? If selecting a limousine for family, please specify how many.

8) LASTINGTRIBUTES AND MEMORIALS

Would you like a lasting tribute, such as a bench, tree planting, or another special memorial, to keep your memory alive for future generations?

9) CHARITABLE DONATIONS

Is there a charity or cause close to your heart that you would like people to donate to in 40° your memory?
